We even have clear guidelines on how they can become collaborative authors and be part of the shared glory when PIC Bone publishes.



Diversity in PIC Bone


The UK and other European countries want research to be more inclusive. We are delighted that our PIC Bone participants are an incredibly diverse bunch!









Recruitment Updates: STUDY CHARTS
