They have interviewed 25 family members and 11 health professionals from across England and Wales. This study is now reaching its conclusion and we'll be able to let you know the results soon!


Thank you to all of you who have contributed to this study - both by involving children and their families, and by taking part in health professionals interviews. 🦙 🥍

• Mr James Robb (SSC Chair) and the other SSC members congratulated the team for their excellent progress and look forward to viewing the results.



















## **Recruitment Updates - Study Charts:**
